Description:

In our society, money, its use or misuse, dominates most peoples' lives. Recently this has become abundantly clear with the world economic crisis. Money now occupies a part of life in our society that is unique in history. Yet, for all of this, most people know surprisingly little about money, and this causes great suffering. Not only is there

general ignorance about money and the natural laws that guide it, there is substantial misunderstanding about one's relationship to it. Without a clear picture of an individual's relationship to money, it will be impossible to manage and use it correctly, especially as we move into what many believe to be a money paradigm shift. No schools, spiritual or otherwise, offer such a venue for self-exploration directly related to money. This lack of self-exploration and general ignorance of the principles of money management has led to personal crises as well as our general financial crises.

In this recording, through teaching and inquiry, Mayuri Overheim leads participants through a multi-layered investigation into personal and cultural relationships with money, its laws and principles, its deep entwinement with spirituality, and the tools which can help create clear financial structure in our lives.
